LOCKER USE AND CARE

Lockers are a necessary part of our Middle School Program. Each middle school student is assigned a locker with a combination lock. Books, school supplies, book bags and personal property should be kept in the locker. The intent of having a locker is to provide necessary storage space for materials not required in the classroom so that classrooms remain uncluttered during the school day. The following agreement sets forth expectations students must follow:

1. Lockers must be cleaned and organized on a regular basis.
2. Locks must be on the locker and secured when students leave campus, or a lunch detention will be issued.
3. Students are NOT allowed to keep items in their locker that are in violation of school rules.
4. Locks must be returned at the end of the school year. Students will be assessed an additional \$9.00 fee for a lost or missing lock at the end of the year or during the year.

St. Paul Lutheran School reserves the right to:

1. Open any locker to check for illegal substances or cleanliness.
2. Revoke locker privileges to students who refuse to cooperate with the expectations set forth in this agreement.
