PRE-KINDERGARTEN (4) SUPPLY CHECKLIST
2017-2018

Dear Parents,

Your child will need to bring the supplies listed below for projects that we will be doing in the Pre-Kindergarten (4) Class.

1. A plastic school box approximately 5" X 8" in length to keep crayons, scissors, glue sticks, etc. This should be clearly identified with your child's name.
2. A 4-ounce bottle of white liquid glue (Elmer's School Glue, with regular pointed tip – without wings). No colored glue.
3. 8 - large glue sticks. **PLEASE SELECT THE LARGER (FATTER) GLUE STICKS.** Please label with your child's name, using a black permanent marker.
4. 2-boxes of large Crayola Crayons (NOT THE JUMBO ONES), in 8 basic colors. NO GLITTER CRAYONS, NO NEON CRAYONS, NOTHING FANCY, PLEASE.
5. A box of 24 regular size Crayola Crayons.
6. 1 – pack of Pip Squeak Crayola Markers. They are smaller than regular markers & are recommended for small hands (Walmart, Target or Toy's R Us may offer these).
7. One pair of child size Fiskars blunt metal blade scissors. We have found that Fiskars work the best. Please avoid sending decorative or plastic blade scissors.
8. A standard size rectangle box of tissues, to be placed around the room and shared throughout the year.
9. Ziploc Bags –
snack size (last name a-e)
sandwich size (last name f-l)
quart size (last name m-p)
gallon size (last name q-u)
jumbo size/2 gallon size (last name v-z)
10. Baby wipes refill only (count 120 to 200). Store brand is great (all students)
11. A paint smock. This can be a shirt that has short sleeves and collar removed or a smock that has been purchased. Please be sure it will cover your child's clothing completely.
12. A full size (approx. 12" X 15") school bag or backpack must be brought to school everyday. PLEASE BE SURE THE BAG IS LARGE ENOUGH TO HOLD PAPERS, PROJECTS, AND OTHER SCHOOL ITEMS. No rolling or wheeled backpacks.
13. A 4 X 6 family picture
14. 2 – large container of disinfecting wipes 75 count or more (for teacher use)
15. 1 box standard, plain Band-aids

PLEASE OPEN AND LABEL EACH ITEM WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME. Children do not always recognize their own belongings at this age. During your Home Visit a few other items may be requested.
