

MUSIC AT ST. PAUL LUTHERAN

"Make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all ye lands!" Psalm 100. There are many opportunities for music performance and study at St. Paul Lutheran. Here is an overview:

CLASSROOM MUSIC INSTRUCTION, GRADES 1-8

Grades 1 - 8 have music class once or twice every 7 days for 40 minutes.

A variety of age-appropriate skills and activities are implemented including singing, performing on rhythm instruments, hand chimes and recorders, listening, moving, appreciating, reading and writing music, composing, and studying such topics as instruments, composers, music styles, the elements of music, music from other cultures, and music history.

CHRISTMAS MUSICAL PROGRAM AND SPRING MUSICAL

Twice a year, everyone in Grades 1-8 participates in a musical production (12/13/17 and 5/18/18)

CHOIRS

Everyone in Grades 3-8 has the opportunity to sing in a choir.

Choirs meet once or twice every 7 days, during the school day.

Choirs perform at 2 concerts during the year, at chapels and in Sunday worship, and occasional field trips. There will be more choir information the first week of school.

HANDBELLS

Everyone in Grades 6-8 has the opportunity to play in a handbell choir.

Handbell choirs meet once or twice every 7 days, during the school day.
